KEN-PAM 423 containing 423g/L Metham present as sodium salt is a soil fumigant that successfully controls soil borne pests in a variety of crops - Potatoes, Pineapples, Sugar Cane, a range of Fruit and Vegetable crops, Ornamentals, Fibre crops and Tobacco.

Metham belongs to the dithiocarbamate class of chemicals, and has fungicide, nematocide, herbicide and insecticide activity. KEN-PAM 423 works by producing a highly active methyl isocyanate gas once applied in the soil. This paralyzes soil borne organisms thus giving you an effective control of germinating weed seeds, nematodes, symphylids and Fungus diseases.

BEST USE TIPS

1. Recommended application methods are Soil Injection, Rotary Tiller and Trickle Irrigation.
2. Cultivate soil and dispense of clods. Keep soil moist until application.
3. Do not apply to dry soil.
4. Covering the treated surface with impermeable polythene sheeting ensures better retention of the active gas thus better results.
5. Do not exceed application rates detailed in Product Label.
6. Do not mix with any other pesticide or fertilizer.
7. Do not apply in high wind situations.
8. Do not apply KEN-PAM 423 in low humidity conditions and when temperature is above 32° C.
9. Always follow Label guidelines for application rates and methods.
10. Always be vigilant with the handling of KEN-PAM 423.





SAFE HANDLING OF KEN-PAM 423

- » ALWAYS WEAR the appropriate protective clothing and wash thoroughly and change clothes after handling KEN-PAM 423.
- » Avoid skin contact.
- » Do not inhale fumes or spray mist as KEN-PAM 423 is extremely toxic.
- » Repeated exposure has the potential to cause allergic disorders.
- » KEN-PAM 423 interacts with alcohol, do not consume alcohol when handling this product
- » If product contaminates clothing or comes in contact with skin, eyes or mouth was immediately with soap and water for skin and water for eyes and mouth
- » Wash all clothing after each use of KEN-PAM 423.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS



FOR KEN-PAM 423:

- » Store product in its original sealed container.
- » Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area, out of direct sunlight.
- » Store away from food products, seeds, fertilisers, children and livestock.
- » Do not use container for other purposes and destroy after use in a safe manner.
- » Do not store in below 0°C, product crystallizes at low temperatures.
